Georgia This Indenture made this 20th day
Merriweather County of August One thousand eight
hundred and thirty three between Silas
Moore of the County of Muscogee and State of Georgia of the one
part and Neill Strahan of the County of Merriweather and State
of Georgia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Silas Moore
for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars in
hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted,
bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant
bargain, sell and convey unto the said Neill Strahan his
heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate lying and being
in the Eighth dist^t of the County of Troup formerly now
Merriweather County containing by survey two hundred two &
a half acres known and distinguished in the plan of said
district by the number twenty nine (79) to have and to hold
