 and Leander J. Milam of the other part, both of the County &
 State aforesaid, witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum
 of Twenty-one hundred & forty-two Dollars in hand paid to said
 Mary A. Hood by said L. J. Milam the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, she the said Mary A. Hood has this day bargained
 & sold & by this instrument doth bargain, sell & convey unto the
 said Milam a certain tract or parcel of land in the Middle 9th
 District of Meriwether Co., (formerly the 10th Dist.) it being that part of
 the land purchased by said Hood of Columbus M. Faver on which
 the said Milam at present resides, containing Two hundred &
 thirty-eight acres more or less, consisting of the following parts of
 lots, to wit; one hundred & six acres, more or less, on the East side
 of lot No two hundred & thirty-eight (238) in Middle 9th Dist.
 formerly 10th Dist. including all said lot not heretofore conveyed
 to Morris G. Towles also one acre, more or less, lying in the S.W.
 corner of the East half of lot No Two hundred & thirty-nine
 (239) of said Middle 9th Dist & bounded as follows, commencing
